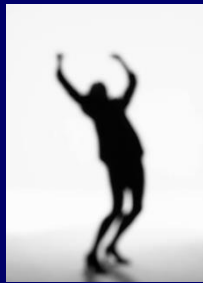

- **WHAT COULD HAPPEN?**

1. Your child stops attending
2. Your child does not complete assignments
3. Your child does not prepare for tests
4. Your child does not pass a required class

HOW CAN WE PREVENT THIS?

1. Ensure you child attends school.

- not only does this prepare them for the real world but it also increases their chances of being successful in class. (Please contact the school if your child is absent)

2. Communication with the teachers is vital to your child's success

- If you want to know if your child is doing his/her part, simply contact his/her teachers. You can do this by calling the school or by emailing individual teachers. (i.e. to contact Dean Bellerose, email at dean.bellerose@ngps.ca.)

3. Ensure that your child keeps up with all notes and assignments and prepares for exams.

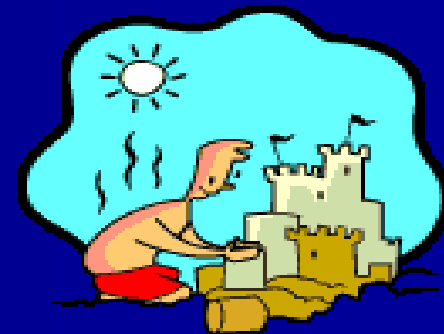
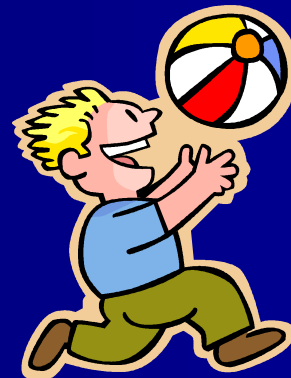

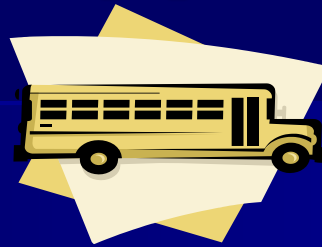
